



## Cases in Brief:

### Searchlight Evidence Management Clients and Projects

This delivers compelling arguments to support litigation teams. Searchlight Evidence Management tools and services have been used on a number of high profile cases and projects including:

#### **WestJet v Air Canada, Calgary, AB**

Working for WestJet in this high profile case, Searchlight has processed and hosted approximately 10 Tb of electronic files and scanned and coded 50 boxes of paper materials since 2005

WestJet Executive Vice President Fred Ring said:

“This lawsuit was a very bitter dispute between two rivals with huge amounts of information to be collected retrieved and stored in a database that was secure yet accessible to our lawyers. Given the sheer volume of documents involved Searchlight provided an excellent way to organize the data, sort through it and produce reports. The potential of the tool was great: it clearly had a lot of flexibility and the ability to do well beyond the tasks we required”

#### **The Hollinger Case**

Since January 2005 Searchlight has processed a large electronic data set and associated paper files for Ernst and Young on behalf of Hollinger

#### **The Air India Terrorism Case**

Working for the defence teams, Searchlight imaged 500,000 pages of documents and coded 1,000,000 pages between July 2001 and June 2003

#### **The Enron Case**

Working in Portland OR Searchlight has organised over 5,000,000 pages of materials since December 2002



## **The Milgard Inquiry**

Between June 2003 and December 2004, Searchlight provided an on site local scanning service for the Department of Justice Saskatchewan in relation to this case and captured 75,000 pages of paper documentation on site. Searchlight is now routinely used for scanning and coding on other Department of Justice cases

## **The US Air Force**

Searchlight has been used for double-entry coding of air craft manuals guaranteeing 99% accuracy. The custom screens were developed by Searchlight's software development team specifically for the purpose

## **R v Trang**

Searchlight was used to scan 50,000 pages and code 700,000 pages of evidence between December 2000 and March 2003

## **King County, Seattle WA**

Between March 2003 and January 2004 Searchlight scanned and coded 50,000 documents relating to a harassment case

## **Holland & Knight LLP Oceanic Bank & Trust Washington DC**

Since June 2005 Searchlight has been engaged to process and host 150 boxes of materials in paper format and 100 Gb of electronic files

## **The Attorney General, State of California**

Between January 2004 and March 2005 Searchlight was used to extract and analyse data from over 200 backup tapes

## **Kirkland & Ellis LLP, Washington DC**

Working on behalf of Siemens, Searchlight has been used to process and host documents from 50 boxes of printed material and 50 Gb of electronic files since July 2005

## **R v Clark**

Searchlight was used to code and organise 20,000 documents for this case during March 2000

## **Pillsbury Winthrop LLP, San Francisco CA**

Between February 2004 and April 2005 Searchlight coded 100,000 documents for a case managed by this firm

## **Grey Carey LLP, Seattle WA**

Searchlight has processed a large electronic file data set for this firm on behalf of Network Commerce. The work commenced in March 2003 and continues



## **Boeing v ICO Slough UK**

Between November 2004 and February 2005, Searchlight scanned 550 boxes of paper documentation on site in relation to this case

## **US v Stringer Portland OR**

Since December 2004 Searchlight has organised 1,000,000 documents for this case. Work continues

## **MDI v Atomic Energy of Canada, Toronto ON**

Between June and August 2005 Searchlight organised 35,000 documents related to this case
